

# **KARAOKE LOUNGE**

## **SONG SELECTION AND ALLOCATION**

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**



1. A member upon arrival at the Karaoke Lounge is to exchange his membership card for a table (or queue) number with the GRO to enable him to key in his song selections on the KOD system.
2. Allocation of table numbers is strictly on a first-come-first-served basis. The order of allocation will be maintained by the KOD system and cannot be altered manually.
3. Table numbers will be allocated according to the following entitlement:
  - \* Individual members and members with up to 2 guests - 1 table number
  - \* Members with 3 to 5 guests - 2 table numbers
  - \* Members with 6 or more guests - 3 table numbers.
4. Members must inform the GRO to close their table numbers when they decide not to continue singing and are leaving the Karaoke Lounge. They are not allowed to pass on their table numbers to any others.
5. A Member should select his songs quickly once a table number is allocated in order to confirm his place in the queue. If not, he may lose his turn to another table number which enters a song selection before him on the system.
6. A Member is to key in his selections personally on the song selector machine. A Member can key in more songs than his eligibility but will be allocated only one song in each cycle.
7. The KOD system will display the table number and song title on the screen. A Member must be present when his table number is displayed; otherwise he will forfeit his turn. However, a Member can allow his guest or another Member to sing in his place.
8. A Member can make new song selections while singing is in progress but the order of allocation will be according to the cycle.
9. Only songs in the KOD system will be played. Discs submitted by members will not be played to avoid infringement of copyright laws.
10. Management reserves the right to amend these rules and regulations at any time without prior notice.
